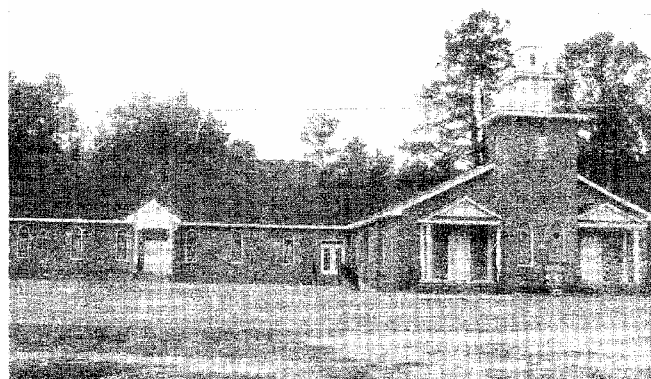

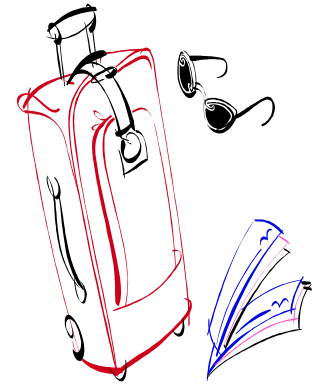
IGNITING THE GENIUS IN EACH OF US
